Kaddie Mahoney Platt is in her 16th season as head volleyball coach for Houston Baptist University. Last season, HBU enjoyed its second 20+ win season since beginning the transition back to NCAA Division I. During the 2007 campaign, while achieving her 400th career victory, she led the Huskies to a 26-3 record in their first year back in the NCAA Division I ranks. Platt, who holds a 447-115 record as a head coach, created an NAIA volleyball power house in her first 12 seasons at HBU, leading the Huskies to eight conference championships, five regional titles and six appearances at the NAIA National Tournament. The Huskies enjoyed their most successful season in 2002 when HBU was the NAIA national championship runner-up, garnering Platt National Coach of the Year and National Tournament Coach of the Year honors. Platt has coached 51 All-Conference players with 17 of those going on to receive All-America honors. She has coached eight conference players of the year and four conference setters of the year. She also places great importance on the academic side of her athletes and has coached 72 academic all-conference honorees with 15 of those progressing to achieve academic all-America status. In 2007, the Huskies earned an AVCA Team Academic Award, one of 70 NCAA Division I programs to be recognized for academic excellent by maintaining at least a 3.30 GPA on a 4.0 scale.



Steve Greene is entering his second season with the Huskies after two years as assistant coach at California State University Monterey Bay. He also has extensive high school experience as head coach at Notre Dame High School in Salinas, Calif., from 2004-2007, where he was named Monterey County Coach of the Year and earned the Central Coast Section Championship Coach award in 2004. He also started the program and served as head coach at Saint Francis High School in Watsonville, Calif., and began his career as an assistant coach at Archbishop Mitty in San Jose, Calif., in 2000, helping lead his team to two state titles and three national Top-10 finishes. He also coached at the club level from 2002-2007, with Main Beach, Salinas Valley and Vision Volleyball Clubs, until founding Sensation Volleyball Club in 2006. Greene was the setter and team captain at Irvine Valley College from 1997-1998 and 1999-2000, before earning his kinesiology degree from CSU Monterey Bay.



Nicole Westerterp is entering her second season as graduate assistant coach at HBU, returning to her alma mater, where she is one of the most-decorated athletes in program history. Westerterp became a four-time all-American, all-region and all-Red River Athletic Conference selection for the Huskies. She was also named Red River Athletic Conference player of the year in 2004 and 2006 and voted to the national all-tournament team in 2003 after leading HBU to a conference title, then added another championship in 2006. Westerterp earned region player of the year honors in 2006 and was also tabbed region front row specialist of the year and made the region all-tournament team. She was named region freshman of the year in 2003. In addition to her many accolades, Westerterp ranks as the Huskies' all-time leader in kills (1,954), blocks solo (345) and blocks assisted (496), and ranks third in service aces (212). She was inducted into the HBU Sports Hall of Honor in 2008. Following her career, she became the assistant coach at Lee College and was the head coach for Texas Eastside Volleyball Club's 15 & 16's team in 2008 and 2009. She has also coached for Houston Juniors and assisted with camps at HBU, Rice and Texas.
